



**DEED OF VARIATION
OF SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT**

ST JOSEPH'S and ST GREGORY'S CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL

The Parties to this Deed are:

(1) **The Secretary of State for Education** of Sanctuary Buildings, Great Smith Street, London SW1P 3BT (the “**Secretary of State**”);

- and –

(2) **St Francis of Assisi Academies Trust**, a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered company number 08462151, whose registered office is at Tyne Crescent Bedford MK41 7UL (“the Company”)

together referred to as the “**Parties**”.

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into supplemental funding agreements on 1st April 2013 in respect of St Joseph’s Catholic Lower School and St Gregory’s Catholic Middle School copies of which are contained in Schedule 1, (the “**Existing SFAs**”).
- B. The Company is to merge St Joseph’s Catholic Lower School and St Gregory’s Catholic Middle School.
- C. The Parties have agreed to amend and re-state the terms of the Existing SFA’s, in accordance with the terms of this Deed to merge both schools with effect from 1st September 2017 to create St Joseph’s and St Gregory’s Catholic Primary School.

LEGAL AGREEMENT

- 1. Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Supplemental Funding Agreement (as defined in clause 2 below). For the avoidance of doubt, the Schedules form part of this Deed.
- 2. The Secretary of State and the Company agree that with effect from the date of this Deed, the Existing SFA’s shall be amended and re-stated in the form of the Supplemental Funding Agreement contained in Schedule 2 (the “**Supplemental Funding Agreement**”)

GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

- 3. This Deed, and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the law of England and Wales.
- 4. The Parties irrevocably agree that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of, or in connection with, this deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

COUNTERPARTS

5. This Deed may be executed in any number of counterparts and by the parties to it on separate counterparts, each of which when so executed and delivered shall be an original, but all the counterparts shall together constitute one and the same instrument.
